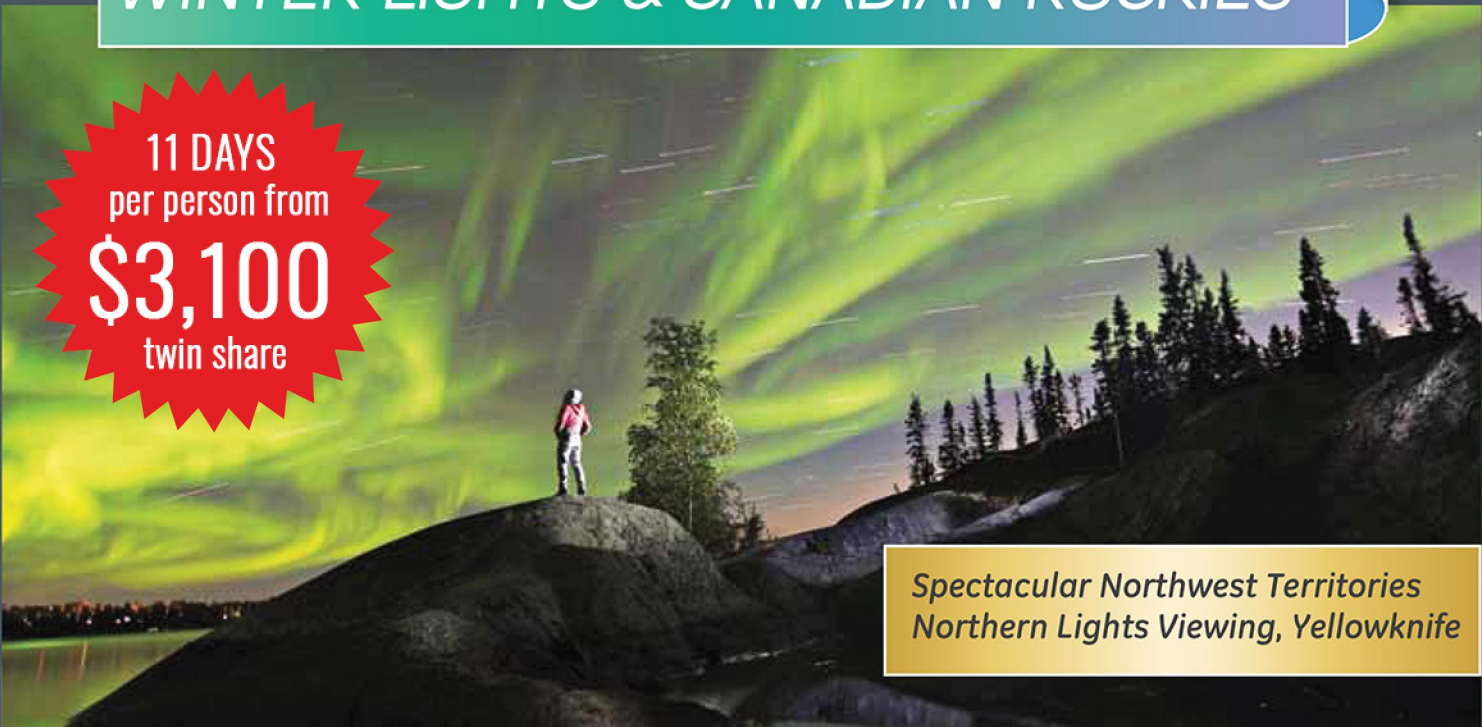

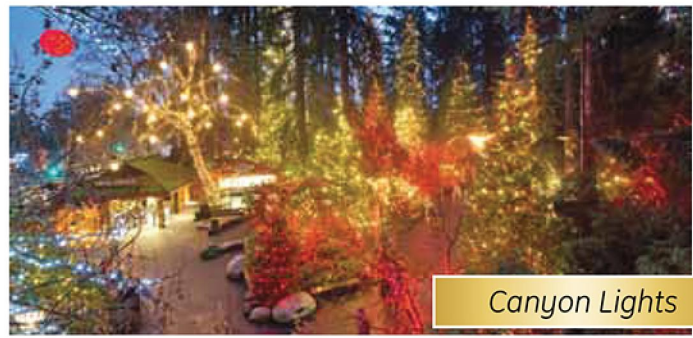

## Day 1 & Day 2: Discover Vancouver

Check into your hotel and then head out to discover the city. We have included a hop on hop off 1 day pass. Capilano Christmas Lights are on from the 22nd Nov – 26th January, Christmas Night Markets run from the 21st Nov – 24th Dec, the city comes alive with winter light festivals during this time of the year.

## Day 3: Vancouver – Yellowknife

Fly to Yellowknife known as the "Aurora Capital of the World". Settle into your downtown hotel. It's now time to get fitted for your winter clothing, or it can be pre-booked and sent to your hotel.

## Day 4 & Day 5: Yellowknife – Northern Lights & More!

During the day you will explore Yellowknife, included during your stay:

- Aurora Viewing – drive to a cozy wilderness cabin on Great Slave Lake for two evenings of Aurora Viewing
- Ice Road Tour
- Yellowknife City & Local Art tour.

Optional activities include ice fishing, dog sledding and snowshoeing!

## Day 6: Yellowknife – Calgary – Banff

Take a direct flight to Calgary and then transfer to your lodge or hotel in the village of Banff for a three night stay.

## Day 7 & Day 8: Explore Banff

There is so much to see and do! We have included the following tours.

- Discover Banff & It's Wildlife- morning tour
- Afternoon Horse Drawn Sleigh Ride
- Johnston Canyon Ice Walk
- Snowshoeing in the Kootenay National Park to Paint Pots

## Day 9: Banff – Lake Louise

A drive along the scenic Bow Valley brings you to the village of Lake Louise where you spend the next two nights. This afternoon explore the village - go ice skating on Lake Louise, strap on a pair of snowshoes for an invigorating walk or take a leisurely horse sleigh ride.

The Ice Magic Festival is being held in Lake Louise from the 15th to 26th January, this is a world-class ice carving event. Walk through a winter wonderland and explore ice castles, ice bars and ice carvings, view the carvers as they work to complete their works of art.

## Day 10: Lake Louise

Enjoy a morning of dog sledding, then the afternoon is yours, head to the Chateau Lake Louise for some of the best fondue in town, visit the Lodge of Ten Peaks at the base of Lake Louise Ski Resort for lunch and then catch the sightseeing gondola to the top for sweeping views of the Victoria Glacier and Lake Louise.

## Day 11: Lake Louise – Calgary

Today you will transfer by coach to Calgary Airport where your journey ends.

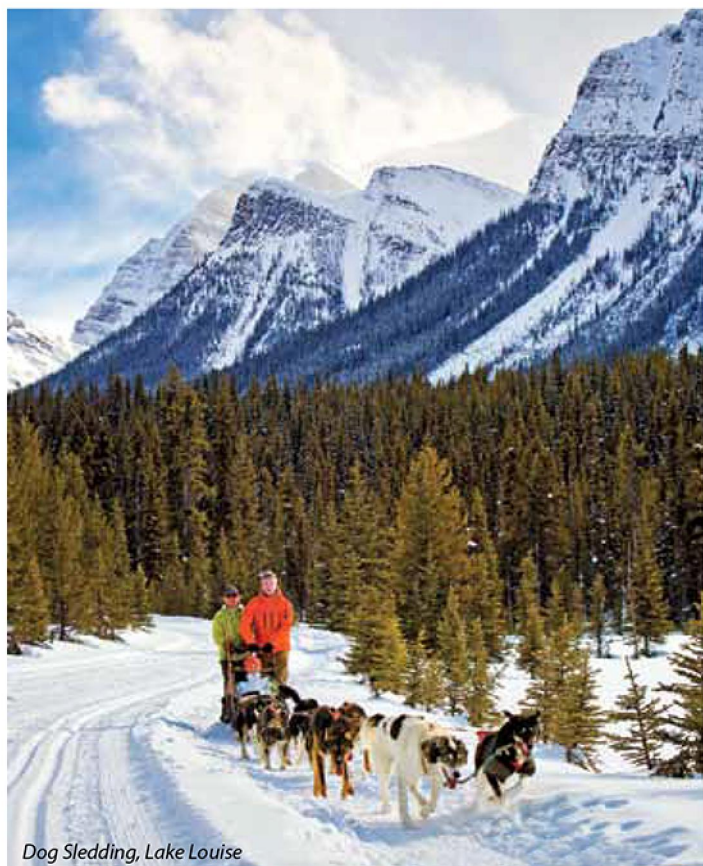
